Bonjour Preschool Parents,

Our theme in November is fairy tales/les contes de fees and storytelling/les histoires. We will learn about different kinds of bears, what they eat, how and where they live and also all about hibernation. We will be having a lot of fun hearing fairytales and fictional stories about bears, creating some “beary” fun crafts and learning some new songs.

In addition to our bear/fairytales theme this month we will keep working with new letters and numbers. We will also print our names using tracing activities for the T/Th groups and our M/W/F groups will be encouraged to print their own names on all of their artwork and other paperwork. This should be a very fun and exciting month and I look forward to learning along with your littles.

Sharing for this month is “your favourite stuffed animal”. Have your child bring their favourite stuffed animal on their sharing day.

This trip will most likely take place in the morning on both field trip days. I will be needing parent volunteers to come along on this trip and will post a sign up sheet as soon as possible.

I will place November book order forms in your child’s mailbox early next week. Book orders are due by **Friday, November 16th**. Thank you to everyone who placed orders last month, with your help I was able to add a few more items to our classroom library recently!

As the weather begins to turn and the ground becomes wet and snowy I am asking everyone to please remember to remove all outdoor footwear and place shoes/boots on the boot racks in the school’s front entrance. Please do not bring outdoor footwear into the classroom.
